<p>The overall objective of the project is to improve the animal health in Serbia and surrounding Countries in line with EU standards, thus improving the prospects for trade of agricultural products. Specific objectives are: to eradicate, control and monitor rabies in foxes in the Republic of Serbia; to eradicate, control and monitor CSF in feral pig population as well as to prevent the spread of CSF from feral pig population to domestic pigs.
