

CONTINGENT WORK CONTRACT AS "MEMBER OF THE SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEE FOR THE VALUATION OF IZSAM RESEARCH PROPOSALS"

Ref: Resolution of the Director General n. 296 of 22nd July 2019 Published on the Headquarter's register of Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale dell'Abruzzo e del Molise "G. Caporale" of Teramo (hereinafter also referred to as "IZSAM") on 23nd July 2019

Assignments

- To provide, on request of the General Director or the Scientific Director and in compliance with the Rules of the Technical Scientific Committee, evaluations of research and development proposals with reference to:
 - a. Scientific quality of the proposed research;
 - b. Novelty, innovation and portability of scientific results;
 - c. Methodology and development strategy of the project, preliminary data and bibliographic references;
 - d. Merit of the applicant and expertise of the group of researchers;
 - e. Facilities, infrastructures, and equipment to be used for the implementation of the project.
- To provide, on request of the General Director or the Scientific Director, technical and scientific advice on topics related to research or on project hypotheses.

Eligibility Criteria

A1 At least ten years of professional experience in the specific research area. A2 Advanced knowledge of English, written and spoken.

Failure to meet both the requirements A1 and A2 at the time of submission of the application shall cause the exclusion of the candidate from the selection.

Required skills

Ability to formulate evaluations and/or express scientific opinions, in the specific research field, according to appropriate methods and tools and considering all the possible variables, using English as official working language.

Selection method

Candidates' applications received by the deadline in accordance to the provisions of this notice, will be submitted to a commission suitably appointed. The Commission will

provide a comparative evaluation of the candidates' curricula.

The selective procedure aims to identify a shortlist of eligible candidates (max 3) for each research area. The General Director will use these shortlists for the designations. The Commission will draw up the shortlist for each research area according to the following parameters:

- Quality and type of the candidate's professional experiences in the specific research area (research activities, participation in research projects as "Principal Investigator", participation in research projects as key member of the working group);
- Experience in professional activities carried out in an English-speaking environment:
- Quality and number of scientific publications (related to the application profile) in journals with impact factor.

The General Director will appoint the Members of the scientific committee for the assessment of IZSAM research proposals among the shortlisted candidates.

Terms and conditions of the contract

The contingent work contract will be conferred in the framework of IZSAM's research programs/projects.

The appointed members shall be remunerated at a fixed fee of 300 euros (the amount include all the costs and taxes at the expense of the Institute and the candidate) per evaluation produced (up to a maximum of 3.600 euros per year). Committee members will remain in office for 3 years.

The contract defines every legal, economic, fiscal and social security aspects and contains the express clarification that the tasks will be performed by the appointee without the obligation of exclusivity and with no subordination towards IZSAM. However, the Committee Members will have to report the results of their individual or collective activity as part of the Scientific Committee.

The specific assignments of the General Director or the Scientific Director of the Institute have to be carried out in compliance with the "Regulations of the Technical-Scientific Committee" approved with DDG n. 486/2017. The work performances will be carried out in IZSAM premises or remotely on IZSAM decision.

Terms and conditions of the application

The application form should be submitted using the attached template by 7th August 2019 at the latest to the e-mail address protocollo@pec.izs.it.

The application shall be provided with:

- Curriculum Vitae
- Copy of a valid identity document in pdf format

The incomplete or unclear applications will automatically be rejected.

Failure to meet the requirements A1 and A2 shall cause the exclusion of the candidate from the selection. IZSAM reserves the right to withdraw the selection procedure, with substantiated decision, if requested by the public interest. IZSAM reserves the right to not confer the appointment also in case the selection is occurred.

IZSAM has the right to verify the truthfulness of applicants' declarations under the art. 46 and art. 47 of the DPR (Presidential decree) n° 445/2000. In case of false declaration, without prejudice to criminal penalties provided in the art. 76 of the DPR 445/2000, the applicant loses any benefit resulting from the measure adopted on the basis of false statement.

IZSAM is the controller for the processing of the personal data, in the person of its legal representative, located in Teramo, via Campo Boario, 64100 Teramo, segreteria@izs.it, protocollo@pec.izs.it, 0861 3321. All personal data collected will be processed electronically on digital medium for the purpose of the selecting procedure of IZSAM (D. Lgs. 165/2001 and Reg. (UE) 2016/679 (GDPR) of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016). The provision of such data is mandatory for participating to the selection procedure.

The data processing is made exclusively by IZSAM personnel in charge of the selection procedure. Such processing involves collection, recording, organisation, structuring,

retention, extraction, consultation and elaboration of personal data. These processing activities could be also finalised to publish data on IZSAM website due to binding legal obligations. However, the data shall be published according to the provisions of the D. Lgs. 165/2001 and the Reg. (UE) 2016/679 (GDPR) of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016.

Personal data collected will be retained on both analog and/or digital media, according to the rules to file administrative documents. Data subjects have the right to ask the data controller for accessing their personal data, confirming that such data exist, knowing its content, the origin and the processing procedures, requesting the modification, the cancellation and/or the restriction of data processed in violation of law.

Data subjects who consider that their personal data are processed in breach of what is foreseen by the Reg.
